**RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT THE CENTENNIAL-VOLLMER CONSTRUCTION
PROJECT AT WARTBURG COLLEGE**

WHEREAS, Wartburg College is in Bremer County, and

WHEREAS, Wartburg College has a significant impact on the overall economic activities within Bremer County, and

WHEREAS, Wartburg College has submitted a nomination to the National Register of Historic Places to create the Wartburg College Historic District, and

WHEREAS, the State Historical Preservation Office (SHPO) has determined that Wartburg's nomination for a historic district meets the criteria for Wartburg College to apply for state historic tax credits related to qualified projects, and

WHEREAS, Wartburg College is currently working on an eligible construction/remodel project for a residence hall (Centennial-Vollmer Project) that will have qualified eligible expenses under the state historic tax credit program, and

WHEREAS, this construction/remodel project will cost approximately \$12 million and will be completed in the fall 2023, and

WHEREAS, such a construction/remodel project brings workers to Bremer County who spend money in Bremer County that might not otherwise happen if there were not working on this project, and

WHEREAS, remodeling this residence hall will allow Wartburg College to attract and retain more students, which means these students will be living in Bremer County and spending money that they might not otherwise spend here if they were not living on campus, and

WHEREAS, the Bremer County Supervisors are supportive of this construction/remodel project,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Bremer County Board of Supervisors supports the Centennial-Vollmer construction/remodel project.
