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REQUIREMENTS FOR UTILITY CROSSING ON CITY ROADS

- 1 Reinstatement must be carried out at the conclusion of crossing;
- 2 All asphalt roads will be cut by concrete or asphalt saws so as to have a smooth edge.
- 3 The completed crossing shall be properly backfilled with 3/4" road base (per UTBC) and completed in 8" layers with a mechanical compactor. The top 4" will be compacted with 1/2" plant mix asphalt.
- 4 If the road is graveled the top 8" will be replaced with 3/4" gravel and finished to provide for a comfortable crossing by a vehicle.
- 5 It shall remain the permit holder's responsibility for repairs and maintenance for two (2) years after approval. It is therefore in the permit holders best interest to ensure quality workmanship.
- 6 MAXIMUM LENGTH OF OPEN TRENCH when paralleling a road, except by permission of the City, must be 600 feet, or the distance necessary to accommodate the amount of pipe installed in a single day, whichever is greater. The distance is a collective length at any location, including open excavation, pipe laying and appurtenant construction and back fill which has not been temporarily resurfaced.
- 7 The Authority does not supersede federal or state regulations.
- 8 Permittee must apply for permit to install anything in the road right-of-way regardless if it is across the road or down the side.
- 9 Duchesne City will not be responsible for any damages to any utilities, including pipelines that are installed in the City road right-of-way.
- 10 It will be the responsibility of the Permittee to use traffic control signs as described in the manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices.
- 11 Open trenches cannot stay open for more than 10 hours without city approval.
- 12 All road bores will need to be inspected at a rate of \$60/Hr.
