

**RESOLUTION NO. 12**  
**(Series of 2022)**

**RESOLUTION GIVING NOTICE OF AND CALLING FOR A SPECIAL TOWN ELECTION TO BE HELD NOVEMBER 8, 2022, AND SUBMITTING A BALLOT QUESTION CONCERNING IMPOSITION OF A SALES TAX ON LODGING SERVICES**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Georgetown is a Colorado municipal corporation operating under a Territorial Charter and governed by its Board of Selectmen; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Selectmen (the “Board”) is authorized to adopt such rules, regulations and restrictions for the protection of the public health, safety and welfare; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Selectmen wishes to refer a ballot question to the registered electors of the Town at a special town election to be coordinated with the November 8, 2022 general election.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN FOR GEORGETOWN, COLORADO:**

**Section 1.** The Board of Selectmen hereby gives notice of and calls a special Town election to be coordinated with the general election on November 8, 2022.

**Section 2.** **Ballot Question referred to voters.** Pursuant to CRS 31-11-111(2), the Board hereby refers the following ballot question to the registered electors of the Town at the November 8, 2022, election. The ballot title shall be the text of the ballot issue and question itself:

SHALL TOWN OF GEORGETOWN TAXES BE INCREASED \$225,000 IN THE FIRST FISCAL YEAR (2023) AND BY WHATEVER ADDITIONAL AMOUNTS ARE RAISED ANNUALLY IN EACH SUBSEQUENT YEAR, THROUGH A TWO PERCENT (2%) TOWN SALES TAX ON LODGING SERVICES, COMMENCING ON JANUARY 1, 2023, THE REVENUES FROM SUCH TAX TO BE USED SOLELY FOR SUPPORT OF THE ACTIVITIES OF THE TOWN’S BUSINESS PROMOTION COMMISSION, ORGANIZATION, PROMOTION, MARKETING AND MANAGEMENT OF PUBLIC EVENTS, ACTIVITIES IN SUPPORT OF BUSINESS RECRUITMENT, MANAGEMENT AND DEVELOPMENT, COORDINATING TOURISM PROMOTION ACTIVITIES, HOUSING AND CHILDCARE FOR THE TOURISM-RELATED WORKFORCE, INCLUDING SEASONAL WORKERS AND FOR OTHER WORKERS IN THE COMMUNITY, FACILITATING AND ENHANCING VISITOR EXPERIENCES, INCLUDING EXTENDED SEASONAL MAINTENANCE AND USE OF THE GUANELLA PASS SCENIC BYWAY, CAPITAL

EXPENDITURES FOR HOUSING AND CHILDCARE FOR THE TOURISM-RELATED WORKFORCE, INCLUDING SEASONAL WORKERS AND FOR OTHER WORKERS IN THE COMMUNITY, AND CAPITAL EXPENDITURES RELATED TO FACILITATING AND ENHANCING VISITOR EXPERIENCES, AND SHALL ALL REVENUES GENERATED FROM THE SALES TAX AUTHORIZED HEREBY AND FROM ANY EARNINGS FROM THE INVESTMENT OF SUCH REVENUES CONSTITUTE A VOTER APPROVED REVENUE CHANGE AND EXCEPTION TO THE REVENUE AND SPENDING LIMITS OF ARTICLE X SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION?


**Section 3.**    **Effective date.** This Resolution shall be effective upon passage.
