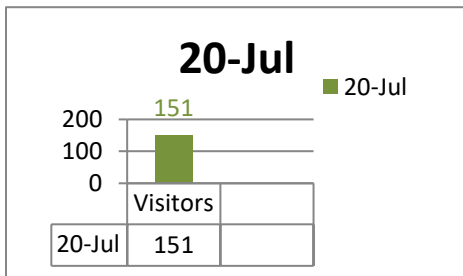


# Gordonsville's Visitor Center
