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BACKGROUND:

This matter has been placed on Council’s agenda at their request as an on-going item of discussion regarding the Town’s use of CARES Act funding allocated to the Town.

From July 1 – September 30, 2020, \$30,033.59 was expensed for the Town’s CARES Act related materials or services. This amount includes approximately \$11,392 in costs for staff time, dating back to mid-March, related to COVID-19 preparation and response.

As approved by Council, \$45,000 has been provided to the Orange County Department of Social Services for their use in providing utility/rent/mortgage assistance to Gordonsville residents. The Gordonsville Gives Back small business grant program was implemented in late September, with grant applications accepted from October 5th through October 19th. Staff will update Council at the October meeting as to the number of applications received.

The non-profit agencies to which Council allocated a direct donation from its CARES Act funding have been contacted and provided with a Memorandum of Understanding they must sign and return prior to the disbursement of funds to their organization.

No action is requested by Council at this time.
