BACKGROUND:

On February 22, 2021 Council acted to close the Dix Memorial Pool for the 2021 season due to COVID-19 concerns and meeting physical-distancing requirements still in place.

At the May 17, 2021 Council meeting, in light of information regarding eased COVID-19 restrictions expected for the summer, Council discussed the opening of Dix Memorial Pool during the week or at least on weekends starting in July and running through August if staff could be hired to manage and operate the facility.

At the writing of this summary, there are no viable applications for Pool Manager or Pool Lifeguard. In response to Council's request, staff reached out to various points of contact to find someone available to teach lifeguard certification at the pool; at this time, there is no one available to do so.

Staff recommends the Town continue to take a wait-and-see approach over the next few weeks and endeavor to open the pool on weekends in August if staffing becomes available.
