Street Construction: Directly Impacted Property Owners

Frequently Asked Questions

Will the street/road be closed?	No. In the strictest sense, the road will never be closed; however, barricades and signs may be posted indicating the road is closed to through traffic. Access will be maintained to homes and business (if any) along the construction corridor.
Will my garbage collection day change?	No.
Will Granger be able to collect my garbage?	Yes. In the very rare event that the truck cannot make it to your address, arrangements will be made for your garbage to be taken to the truck and your trash cans returned to your house.
Will mail or other deliveries be impacted?	No. Mail and all other delivery services will be able to access your house/mailbox throughout construction.
Will emergency vehicles be able to access my street?	Yes. Emergency vehicles will always be able to access the street during construction.
Will I be able to access my driveway?	Yes. Driveway access will be maintained; however, depending on the construction activity you may be asked to park on an adjacent side street or wait to enter your driveway until the activity has passed your address.
What time will work start and end?	Work hours are established by City Ordinance, 7 AM to 7 PM, Monday through Saturday. Work is generally prohibited on Sunday.
Will I lose power or water service?	If your water service is scheduled for replacement, you will receive notification (usually by a door hanger) indicating the date and time your water service may be interrupted. This construction activity should not result in the interruption of power to your home.
