

RESOLUTION NO. 17-57

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TREASURE ISLAND AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE A NEW 2017 FORD ESCAPE SUV FROM HUB CITY FORD THROUGH THE FLORIDA SHERIFF'S ASSOCIATION COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM; INCLUDING ANCILLARY EQUIPMENT IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$19,460.00; AND AUTHORIZING AN APPROPRIATION FROM THE LOISS FUND UNASSIGNED FUND BALANCE TO ACCOUNT 123-5300-64920 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$19,460.00 FOR THE PURCHASE OF THIS VEHICLE AND EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, the Treasure Island Police Department has operated a Parking Enforcement Division for the community since 1996, providing an invaluable resource to address on-going violations of the City's parking ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the current Parking Enforcement vehicle has experienced on-going mechanical and electrical issues over the past year, and additional diagnostics and repair work to the vehicle are no longer cost effective; and

WHEREAS, the Treasure Island Police Department endeavors to continue providing Parking Enforcement Operations to our busy community in a properly equipped, safe and reliable replacement vehicle; and

WHEREAS, Hub City Ford submitted the winning quote through the Florida Sheriff's Association Cooperative Purchasing Program in the amount of \$17,960.00, and additional costs for transferring existing emergency equipment, purchase of a new Mobile Data Terminal stand and the addition of "Parking Enforcement" vehicle graphics will not exceed \$1,500.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TREASURE ISLAND DOES RESOLVE THAT:

Section 1. The staff is authorized to purchase a new 2017 Ford Escape SUV in the amount of \$17,960.00 from Hub City Ford through the Florida Sheriff's Association Cooperative Purchasing Program. In addition, staff is authorized to purchase a new Mobile Data Terminal stand and "Parking Enforcement" vehicle graphics in the amount of \$1,500.00.

Section 2. The City Commission authorizes a budget appropriation from the LOISS Fund Unassigned Fund Balance to account 123-5300-64920 in the amount of \$19,460.00 for the purchase of this vehicle and equipment.
