

**ORDINANCE 2021-07**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TREASURE ISLAND, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2021 GENERAL FUND PARKING PROGRAM BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE \$6,600 FROM THE UNASSIGNED FUND BALANCE TO UPGRADE A PARKING ENFORCMENT SPECIALIST POSITION FROM PART-TIME TO FULL-TIME; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; CONFLICT; AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Ordinance 2020-07, the City of Treasure Island, Florida adopted an annual operating budget for fiscal year 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, parking activity throughout the city has increased, therefore justifying an increased in parking enforcement efforts; and

**WHEREAS**, a part-time parking enforcement specialist was funded as of FY 2020, however, it has been difficult to hire and retain personnel in a part-time capacity; and

**WHEREAS**, upgrading the part-time parking enforcement specialist to full-time will increase the City's ability to recruit and retain personnel while enhancing parking enforcement throughout the City; and

**WHEREAS**, parking fine revenue has increased over the past two fiscal years sufficient to support two full-time parking officers; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the City's Charter and generally accepted accounting principles, the City of Treasure Island finds it in the public's best interest to amend the City's budget to appropriate funding to support upgrading the parking specialist position to a full-time position.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF TREASURE ISLAND DOES ORDAIN:**

**SECTION 1.** The recitals set forth in the "Whereas" clauses above are ratified and confirmed as true and correct, and are hereby adopted as legislative findings by the City Commission of the City of Treasure Island, Florida for the adoption of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 2.** The FY 2021 General Fund Parking Program Budget for the City of Treasure Island, Florida, as adopted pursuant to Ordinance 2020-07, is hereby amended by appropriating \$6,600 from the unassigned fund balance to support upgrading the parking specialist position from a part-time to a full-time position for the remainder of the fiscal year.

**SECTION 3.** That allocation of said funds shall be as follows:




