

ORDINANCE 2021-21

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TREASURE ISLAND, FLORIDA, AMENDING ORDINANCE 2021-05 TO ALLOW FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF CITY MONIES TO ANY APPROVED VENDOR IN SUPPORT THE PLANNING AND BUILDING PROGRAMS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; CONFLICT; AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 2020-07, the City of Treasure Island, Florida adopted an annual operating budget for fiscal year 2021; and

WHEREAS, on April 6, 2021 the Commission approved an amendment to the FY2021 operating budget to appropriate additional funds for Building Department contractual support; and

WHEREAS, the City only had one such vendor under contract at the time and inadvertently referenced that firm in Ord. 2021-05; and

WHEREAS, the City has entered into an agreement with supplementary vendor to assist in these efforts; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF TREASURE ISLAND DOES ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. The recitals set forth in the “Whereas” clauses above are ratified and confirmed as true and correct, and are hereby adopted as legislative findings by the City Commission of the City of Treasure Island, Florida for the adoption of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. The Building Fund Budget for the City of Treasure Island, Florida for the fiscal year 2021, as adopted pursuant to Ordinance 2020-07 and amended by Ord. 2021-05 appropriating funding for additional resources for a specific vendor to the Planning and Building Programs, is hereby amended to allow for the expenditure of these funds to any approved City vendor contracted to perform such services.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY. It is declared to be the intent of the City Commission, that if any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

SECTION 4. CONFLICT. This action supersedes all ordinances and resolutions of the City or portions thereof, in conflict with or inconsistent with this ordinance, to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage.

FIRST READING and PUBLIC HEARING on the 19th day of October, 2021.

SECOND READING and PUBLIC HEARING on the 3rd day of November, 2021.




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
