

ORDINANCE 2022-06

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TREASURE ISLAND, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2022 GENERAL FUND AND BUILDING FUND BUDGETS TO APPROPRIATE \$28,970 AND \$9,780 RESPECTIVELY FOR A TOTAL OF \$38,750 FROM THE UNDESIGNATED FUND BALANCES TO FUND THE A NEW PLANNER POSITION FOR THE REMAINDER OF FY22; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; CONFLICT; AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 2021-17, the City of Treasure Island, Florida adopted an annual operating budget for fiscal year 2022; and

WHEREAS, due to increased building and development projects in the City, staff has recommended the addition of a new Planner position to be assigned to the General and Building Fund; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City's Charter and generally accepted accounting principles, the City of Treasure Island finds it in the public's best interest to amend the City's budget to appropriate \$38,750 from the undesignated fund balances from the General (\$28,970) and Building (\$9,780) Funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF TREASURE ISLAND DOES ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. The recitals set forth in the "Whereas" clauses above are ratified and confirmed as true and correct and are hereby adopted as legislative findings by the City Commission of the City of Treasure Island, Florida for the adoption of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. The budget for the City of Treasure Island, Florida for the fiscal year 2022, as adopted pursuant to Ordinance 2021-17, is hereby amended by appropriating \$38,750 from the undesignated fund balances of the General Fund (\$28,970) and the Building Fund (\$9,780) to fund this position for the remaining 5 months of FY22.

SECTION 3. That allocation of said funds shall be as follows:

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. It is declared to be the intent of the City Commission, that if any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

SECTION 5. CONFLICT. This action supersedes all ordinances and resolutions of the City or portions thereof, in conflict with or inconsistent with this ordinance, to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage.

SECOND READING and PUBLIC HEARING on the 5th day of April, 2022.
