

ORDINANCE 2023-05

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TREASURE ISLAND, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2023 GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE \$156,550 FROM THE UNDESIGNATED FUND BALANCE TO FUND THE PURCHASE OF A REPLACEMENT GENERATOR FOR THE TRI-CITIES EMERGENCY OPERATIONS CENTER; IDENTIFYING FUNDING SOURCES FROM THESE PARTNER CITIES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; CONFLICT; AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 2022-12, the City of Treasure Island, Florida adopted an annual operating budget for fiscal year 2023; and

WHEREAS, the cities of Treasure Island, St. Pete Beach, and South Pasadena partner together for emergency operations, including the use of the Pasadena Community Church at 227 70th St. S. St. Petersburg, FL as the secondary Emergency Operations Center (EOC); and

WHEREAS, due to maintenance concerns regarding the existing generator for the City's Emergency Operations Center, staff recommends pursuing the replacement of this unit this year versus next year as originally planned; and

WHEREAS, the five-year capital plan in the adopted FY23 budget includes the replacement of this generator in FY24, and sufficient funding is available to move this purchase to FY23; and

WHEREAS, the City of Treasure Island is coordinating the purchase of this generator, however, the Cities of St. Pete Beach and S. Pasadena will be reimbursing the city a third of the cost of the generator each; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City's Charter and generally accepted accounting principles, the City of Treasure Island finds it in the public's best interest to amend the City's budget to appropriate \$156,550 from the undesignated fund balance from the General Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF TREASURE ISLAND DOES ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. The recitals set forth in the "Whereas" clauses above are ratified and confirmed as true and correct, and are hereby adopted as legislative findings by the City Commission of the City of Treasure Island, Florida for the adoption of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. The budget for the City of Treasure Island, Florida for the fiscal year 2023, as adopted pursuant to Ordinance 2022-12, is hereby amended by appropriating \$156,550 from the undesignated fund balance of the General Fund to purchase the planned generator replacement in FY23.

SECTION 3. That allocation of said funds shall be as follows:

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. It is declared to be the intent of the City Commission, that if any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

SECTION 5. CONFLICT. This action supersedes all ordinances and resolutions of the City or portions thereof, in conflict with or inconsistent with this ordinance, to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage.

FIRST READING and PUBLIC HEARING on the 21ST day of MARCH, 2023.

SECOND READING and PUBLIC HEARING on the 2ND day of MAY, 2023.


