

ORDINANCE 2023-02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TREASURE ISLAND, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2023 BUDGET TO REFLECT TWO AUTHORIZED FULL-TIME POSITIONS FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR CLASSIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; CONFLICT; AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 2022-12, the City of Treasure Island, Florida adopted an annual operating budget for fiscal year 2023; and

WHEREAS, the adopted FY 2023 budget authorizes one full-time position for each of the Public Works Director and Asst. Public Works Director classifications; and

WHEREAS, the public works department has had a number of significant projects and initiatives underway of recent and will have going forward for the new several years; and

WHEREAS, this workload and project management has been largely jointly handled by the Public Works Director and the Asst. Public Works Director; and

WHEREAS additionally, the level of leadership being provided by the current Asst. Public Works Director can be recognized and valued by upgrading this position to a co-Public Works Director; and

WHEREAS approval of this amendment would authorize two full-time positions for the Public Works Director and no full-time positions for the Asst. Public Works Director classifications; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City's Charter and generally accepted accounting principles, the City of Treasure Island finds it in the public's best interest to amend the City's budget to change the authorized positions to reflect an upgrade the Asst. Public Works Director Position to Co-Public Works Director.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF TREASURE ISLAND DOES ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. The recitals set forth in the "Whereas" clauses above are ratified and confirmed as true and correct, and are hereby adopted as legislative findings by the City Commission of the City of Treasure Island, Florida for the adoption of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. The FY 2023 Budget for the City of Treasure Island, Florida, as adopted pursuant to Ordinance 2022-12, is hereby amended by authorizing two full-time positions for the Public Works Director Classification and by reducing the authorization to zero full-time positions for the Asst. Public Works Director Classification.

SECTION 3. That allocation of appropriated funds shall not change in the current year's budget, but this change will be reflected in next year's budget.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. It is declared to be the intent of the City Commission, that if any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

SECTION 5. CONFLICT. This action supersedes all ordinances and resolutions of the City or portions thereof, in conflict with or inconsistent with this ordinance, to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage.

FIRST READING and PUBLIC HEARING on the 7th day of February 2023.

SECOND READING and PUBLIC HEARING on the 21st day of February 2023.

PUBLISHED in the Tampa Bay Times on the 8th day of February 2023.


