SHOOTING IN AREA OF OAK STREET AND CHESTNUT STREET, PATERSON

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

November 26, 2022

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Acting Paterson Police Chief Bert Ribeiro announce that at approximately 10:18 p.m. on November 25, 2022, members of the Paterson Police Department were dispatched to the area of Oak Street and Chestnut Street in Paterson, New Jersey on a report of a shooting. Upon arrival, police located a potential crime scene but no victim was located. While en route to the scene, members of the Paterson Police Department were advised that a 30-year-old male Paterson resident had arrived at Saint Joseph's University Medical Center seeking treatment for multiple non-fatal gunshot wounds.

The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
