SHOOTING IN AREA OF SUMMER STREET AND HAMILTON AVENUE IN PATERSON

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

MAY 6, 2022

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Paterson Police Chief Ibrahim Baycora announce that at approximately 10:34 p.m. on May 5, 2022, members of the Paterson Police Department were dispatched to the areas of Ellison Street and Van Houten Street and Fair Street and Paterson Street in Paterson, New Jersey on a report of shots fired. Upon arrival, police located a potential crime scene and a 28-year-old male Paterson resident who had sustained multiple non-fatal gunshot wounds. The victim was immediately transported to Saint Joseph's University Medical Center in Paterson, New Jersey for treatment.

Based on the preliminary investigation, the victim was in the area of Summer Street and Hamilton Avenue in Paterson when he was struck by gunfire.

The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
