

Pine County Fast Grant Program

DEADLINE 4 p.m. Tuesday, November 24, 2020

This grant program will provide up to \$4,000 for each qualified business. To qualify, a business must be:

1. A restaurant, food court, café, coffeehouse, bar, tavern, brewery, microbrewery, distillery, brewer taproom, micro distiller cocktail room, tasting room winery, cidery, clubhouse or dining club as defined in Emergency Executive Order 2020-99; or
2. A Gymnasium, fitness center or recreation center as defined in EEO 2020-99; or
3. A theater, cinema or bowling alley as defined in EEO 2020-99; and
4. In operation during the period March 1, 2020 – November 20, 2020.
5. Located in Pine County
6. Not in bankruptcy
7. Holds a current business license if required
8. Experienced a business expense, business interruption expense, or a loss of business during the period March 1, 2020 - December 1, 2020 in an amount equal to or greater than the grant
