<p>A fence can be put on your property line AS LONG AS YOU KNOW WHERE YOUR PROPERTY LINES ARE. Fences can not be over six (6) feet tall and can not be built past the front of your house. If your subdivision has a Homeowners Association, make sure they allow fences to be built in your neighborhood. If you live on a corner lot you can not erect fencing in an area that will obstruct the view of drivers. For that reason, fencing should be located AT LEAST EIGHT (8) FEET behind the curb of the street. Fences that are built over a utility easement can be taken down by the City or the Utility Contractor if work is needed in that location. It will be up to the homeowner to put the fence back in place after repairs are complete. Fence permits are \$25.00.</p>
