WHEREAS, the California Department of Housing and Community Development (“Department” or “HCD”) has issued a Notice of Funding Availability (“NOFA”) for the Community Development Block Grant Program (“CDBG”), made available from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”), pursuant to the 2021/2022 funding year. The federal Small Cities CDBG program is authorized by the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (“HCDA”) as amended and codified at Title 42 United States Code (U.S.C.) §5301 et. seq., and Subpart 1 of the Federal CDBG Regulations, found at Title 24 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) §570.480. The requirements of the State of California CDBG Program are in California Health and Safety Code (HSC) §§50825-50834; and

WHEREAS, a Resolution authorizing an application, to the California State Department of Housing and Community Development for funding under the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG), pursuant to the 2021/2022 CDBG Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA); and

WHEREAS, the County of Yuba, a political subdivision of the State of California, wishes to submit to the State of California of one or more application(s) in the aggregate amount,

not to exceed, \$1,500,000.00, as described in APPENDIX D attached hereto and made a part of hereof, for the following CDBG activities, pursuant to the 2021/2022 CDBG NOFA; and

Public Service – Vulnerable Population Food Delivery, not to exceed	<u>\$500,000.00</u>
Public Service – Neighborhood Cleanup, not to exceed	<u>\$500,000.00</u>
Public Service – At-Risk Home Weatherization, not to exceed	<u>\$500,000.00</u>

WHEREAS, the County intends to utilize approx. \$23,474.00 in current Program Income “Cash on Hand”, plus anticipated future receipts in an amount not to exceed \$250,000, for the following Public Service Programs; and

Public Service – Vulnerable Population Food Delivery,	not to exceed	<u>\$150,000.00</u>
Public Service – Neighborhood Cleanup,	not to exceed	<u>\$120,000.00</u>

WHEREAS, the County acknowledges compliance with all state and federal public participation requirements in the development of its application(s); and

WHEREAS, the County hereby authorizes and directs the Director of Community Development and Services Agency, or designee*, to execute and deliver all applications and act on the County’s behalf in all matters pertaining to all such applications; and

WHEREAS, that if an application is approved, the Director of Community Development and Services Agency, or designee*, is authorized to enter into, execute and deliver the grant agreement (i.e., Standard Agreement) and any and all subsequent amendments thereto with the State of California for the purposes of the grant; and

WHEREAS, that if an application is approved, the Director of Community Development and Services Agency, or designee*, is authorized to sign and submit Funds Request and all required reporting forms and other documentation as may be required by the State of California from time to time in connection with the Agreement for purposes of the Grant; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Yuba County Board of Supervisors hereby declare:

Section 1. That the above recitals are all true and correct.

Section 2. That the County Board of Supervisors hereby approves a Resolution authorizing the submission of an application, to the California State Department of Housing and Community Development for funding under the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG), pursuant to the 2021/2022 CDBG NOFA; and

Section 3. That the County Board of Supervisors has reviewed and hereby approves the submission to the State of California of one or more application(s) in the aggregate amount, not to exceed, \$1,500,000.00 the following CDBG activities, pursuant to the 2021/2022 CDBG Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA); and

Public Services – Vulnerable Population Food Delivery, not to exceed	<u>\$500,000.00</u>
Public Service – Neighborhood Cleanup, not to exceed	<u>\$500,000.00</u>
Public Service – At-Risk Home Weatherization, not to exceed	<u>\$500,000.00</u>

Section 4. That the County Board of Supervisors hereby approves the utilization of approx. \$23,474.00 in current Program Income “Cash on Hand”, plus anticipated future receipts in an amount not to exceed \$250,000, for the following Public Service Programs; and

Public Service – Vulnerable Population Food Delivery, not to exceed	<u>\$150,000.00</u>
Public Service – Neighborhood Cleanup, not to exceed	<u>\$120,000.00</u>

Section 5. That the County Board of Supervisors acknowledges compliance with all state and federal public participation requirements in the development of its application(s); and

Section 6. The County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes and directs the Director of Community Development and Services Agency, or designee*, to execute and deliver all applications and act on the County’s behalf in all matters pertaining to all such applications; and

Section 7. That if an application is approved, the Director of Community Development and Services Agency, or designee*, is authorized to enter into, execute and deliver the grant agreement (i.e., Standard Agreement) and any and all subsequent amendments thereto with the State of California for the purposes of the grant; and

Section 8. That if an application is approved, the Director of Community Development and Services Agency, or designee*, is authorized to sign and submit Funds Requests and all required reporting forms and other documentation as may be required by the State of California from time to time in connection with the grant; and

Section 9. This Resolution shall take effect upon its adoption.


