RESOLUTION NO. 2022-155

WHEREAS, County Service Area (CSA) No. 60 consists of 9 parcels on Amber Lane, located on the south side of Highway 20, East of Spring Valley Road in the community of Browns Valley;

WHEREAS, CSA No. 60 was created to provide road, drainage, fire suppression and irrigation facilities for an approximate 60 acre single family rural residential development, as approved by LAFCO on July 26, 1996; and

WHEREAS, CSA No. 60 funding is insufficient to provide such services;

WHEREAS, notice was given to all property owners who currently own property within CSA No. 60 requesting adjustment of assessments; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing and proposition 218 vote was held on April 12, 2022;




