WHEREAS, Chapter 2 (commencing with section 15300) of Part 10 of Division 1 of Title 1 of the California Education Code (the “Law”) provides for the formation of school facilities improvement districts consisting of a portion of the territory within a school district for the issuance of general obligation bonds for the improvement of facilities within the school facilities improvement district; and

WHEREAS, for the purposes of financing certain facilities as authorized under the Law, the Wheatland Union High School District (the “District”), on its own initiative, intends to establish two school facilities improvement districts within the boundaries of the District; and

WHEREAS, Section 15303 of the Law provides that before a school facilities improvement district may be established within the boundaries of a county, the board of supervisors of said county must first make the Law applicable within the school district by resolution adopted by majority vote; and

WHEREAS, the proposed school facilities improvement districts of the District are located entirely within the County of Yuba (the “County”); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yuba has determined that it is in the interests of the County to permit the formation of school facilities improvement districts within the District upon appropriate actions by the District in conformance with all applicable laws and regulations:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yuba as follows:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct.

Section 2. Adoption by Resolution. For the purpose of facilitating the formation of school facilities improvement districts within the District, and pursuant to Section 15303 of the Law, the Law is made applicable within the District.

Section 3. Cost Reimbursement. The District shall reimburse the County for any and all costs incurred by the County in conjunction with the formation and implementation of any school facilities improvement district within the District.

Section 4. Indemnification. The District shall indemnify and hold the County and its officers and employees (the "Indemnified Parties") harmless against any and all losses, claims, damages, or liabilities, joint or several, to which Indemnified Parties may become subject because of the District's action or inaction related to the adoption of this Resolution or related to proceedings for the sale, award, issuance and/or delivery of any school facilities improvement district bonds. The District shall reimburse Indemnified Parties for any legal or other expenses incurred in connection with investigating or defending any such claims or actions.

Section 5. Copies of Resolutions. The Clerk of the Board is hereby directed to provide a certified copy of this resolution to the superintendent of the District immediately following its adoption, and to file a copy with the California Debt and Investment Advisory Commission.

Section 6. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption.




